TIPS FROM THE PROS

“ALWAYS PICK A TARGET YARDAGE AND LOCATION”

GOLFERS SOMETIMES DO NOT THINK ABOUT THEIR TARGET WHEN CONSIDERING HOW TO PLAY A SHOT. ALWAYS PICK A TARGET YARDAGE AND LOCATION PRIOR TO HITTING YOUR SHOT.

ON YOUR TEES SHOTS, PICK A CLUB THAT WILL GIVE YOU THE DESIRED APPROACH YARDAGE INTO A GREEN, AND ALSO PICK A POINT IN THE FAIRWAY TO AIM (I UNDERSTAND THAT MANY GOLFERS JUST WANT THE BALL IN PLAY, BUT TRY TO AIM AT SOMETHING BECAUSE YOU WILL BE SURPRISED HOW MANY MORE TIMES YOU WILL GET CLOSE).

WHEN YOU HIT THE BALL INTO THE GREEN, CAREFULLY CHOOSE YOUR CLUB AND DIRECTION BASED ON WHERE THE BEST PUTT WILL BE FROM. FOR INSTANCE, FROM 160 YARDS, IT MAY NOT BE IN YOUR BEST INTEREST TO PLAY AT A PIN TUCKED AWAY BETWEEN A BUNKER AND A WATER HAZARD. TO BE SMART, PLAY FOR AN AREA ON THE MEATIEST PART OF THE GREEN AND TRY TO KNOCK IN THE 20 FOOT PUTT FOR BIRDIE.

IN CONCLUSION, TAKE CONTROL OF YOUR ROUND BY IMPROVING YOUR AIM.

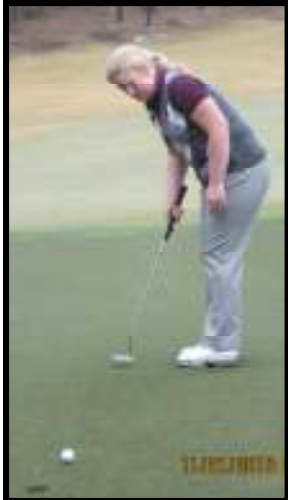
