TIPS FROM THE PROS

“FIX YOUR CLUB RELEASE ON FOLLOW THROUGH”

I NOTICE MORE AND MORE GOLFERS TEND TO HAVE A POOR CLUB RELEASE ON YOUR FOLLOW THROUGH. THIS CAN LEAD TO A NUMBER OF DIFFERENT SHOTS, MOSTLY NOT GOOD...

THE PROPER RELEASE WILL HAVE THE FOREARMS TURNING OVER AFTER IMPACT AND THE CLUBHEAD WILL PASS THROUGH WITH THE HANDS, GIVING YOU A VERTICAL CLUBFACE WHEN THE CLUB IS POINTING NEAR THE TARGET.

WHAT ACTUALLY HAPPENS WITH MANY GOLFERS IS TOO LITTLE CLUB RELEASE. THE RESULT WILL HAVE YOUR HANDS TOO FAR IN FRONT OF THE BALL AT IMPACT, AND WILL CAUSE A WEAK FADE TO THE RIGHT WITH A DIVOT POINTING LEFT.

IDEALLY, YOUR LEFT ARM SHOULD FOLD ON THE FOLLOW THROUGH, AND ALLOW THE RIGHT ARM TO ROTATE OVER IT.

IF YOU NOTICE THAT YOUR LEFT ARM DETACHES FROM YOUR BODY ON THE FOLLOW THROUGH, THIS IS PROBABLY TROUBLESOME TO YOU...

YOU SHOULD PRACTICE SOME SLOW-MOTION SWINGS AND MAKE THE CLUBFACE ROTATE TO SQUARE AT IMPACT AND CLOSED ON THE WAY THROUGH AFTER IMPACT, AND FEEL HOW YOUR ARMS REACT; THEN PRACTICE SPEEDING THE SWING UP UNTIL YOU GET BACK TO FULL SPEED.

What's Happening on the course in November...

For the month of November we'll be doing a lot of tree cleanup and stump grinding in those areas that need it. As far as the greens are concerned, you will notice they will be getting a bit slower for a few weeks because once it gets cold they will pick up speed and I'm worried about how fast they will become in the winter months simply because it's a new grass, on a new site and I need to know how the new greens will react to the weather conditions. I want the course to be a challenge, but I want it to be fair also. I can ALWAYS make them faster but I can't slow them down, so I'd rather use caution until we see the results.

Members, I have an idea I'd like to share with you. If you would be interested in “sponsoring a hole” and choosing some different ornamental grasses and greenery to the areas where we have cut down trees to help with getting sunlight to the greens, please give me, or Robby Watson, a call at Bartram Trail Golf Club. I really want to give these areas a natural look, with some color as well. I believe it will beautify the club, and at the same time give you, the hole “sponsor”, “ownership” in the course.. I have some great ideas, but we need your help and ideas as well. We want you to be a hands-on “sponsor”, so if you have the skills and the vision to beautify these areas of your favorite hole, contact me, or Robby. Let's beautify the course once again and have fun doing it.

What you should be doing at home in November...

You should have put out pre-emergent's by now and watered it in so you can turn off your irrigation system for the winter. You'll need to be ready to rake and blow the leaves for the next few weeks. Then we'll just need to be patient and wait for everything to go dormant and we'll talk about round-up and pruning things down.
