Dear Bartram Trail Golf Club Members and Guests,

I would like to inform you on the proceedings of our tree removal plans. Bartram Trail Golf Club is removing timbers from the golf course property to allow our new "Mini-Verde" Bermuda grass greens more sunlight to supplement their growth. An increase in need for sunlight has forced us to remove many of the trees that currently provide too much shade.

During our tree removal process, there may be areas where piles of lumber and stumps remain in the cleared areas. We assure you that these areas will be cleaned up and beautified once all tree cutting has been completed.

We understand that many members have concerns regarding some of the unfinished areas on the main drive, and I want to inform everyone that we will clean these areas after the timber cutting has been completed. Thank you for being patient with our progress!

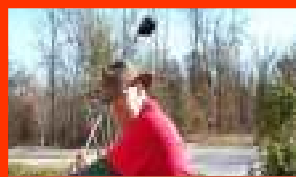

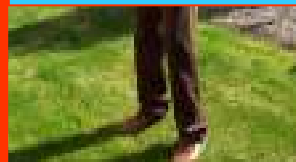

What's Happening on the course in October...

For the month of October at Bartram Trail Golf Club we'll be overseeding our tee boxes sometime around the 13th of the month. Other than that we will be doing basic maintenance work around the course.

We also are continuing our tree cutting as Robby alluded to in his letter on the front page. WE are working on holes #9, 8, 1,2,3 and 17. To let everyone know what exactly we are doing, we have a plan with the work we are doing. I met with the USGA back in July and we discussed the importance of sunlight not only now but in the winter months as well, and that is why we have to go back so far on some holes because the sun's angle is so low in the winter time. Also, you will probably notice that the trees we have cut, and are cutting, are on the south, southwest side of the golf hole because of the path of the sun.

What you should be doing at home in August/September...

It is time to start pre-emerging your yards for winter time weeds. Also putting out some K (0-0-20 the k is the third #on a fertilizer bag) will help winterize your yards for the winter. You can get these products just about anywhere but I do recommend Lesco or I think it may be called John Deere Landscapes now. They are on Riverwatch Parkway just past Stevens Creek Road on the left if you are headed downtown. If you have any questions at all, please give me a call at the course.

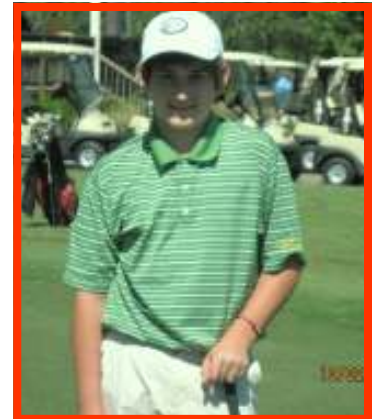
Chip has placed and done very well in AAJGA, AJGM, SJGT, Hurricane and Junior PGA events and tournaments.
