## BARTRAM TRAIL MENS GOLF ASSOCIATION TO HOLD 2-MAN TOURNAMENT JUNE 28th

The Bartram Trail Mens Golf Association is holding a 2-Man Tournament on Saturday, June 28th at Bartram Trail Golf Club. A shotgun start will begin at 8am. Entry fee for the tournament is \$40 per player and includes golf and cart for the members. There is a sign up sheet in the Bartram Trail Golf Club Pro Shop. Entries will close on Wednesday, June 25th at 5:30pm. The tournament will feature three six-hole segments:

Holes #1-6 will be scored as Best Ball of the two players, each having played their own ball until holed out. The best score of the two balls is recorded as the score of record.

Holes #7-12 will be played as a Modified Alternate Shot. Each player will hit their drive, and the best ball is selected to be played next by the player who *did not* hit the ball selected off the tee. The players will then alternate hitting the ball until it is holed out.

Holes #13-18 will be played as a Scramble/Lauderdale/Captain's Choice format.

A single score will be recorded for each hole. A "Team Handicap" will be the average of the two players Handicap's with the exception that if the two players handicaps differ by MORE THAN 10 STROKES, the higher handicap of the two will be reduced to the lower handicap+10 prior to averaging. Players 55-older may play the white tees if they choose but must declare upon signing up to play for handicapping reasons.

This is a great tournament format and we encourage as many members to play as possible. If you have any questions about the format, please contact the Bartram Trail Golf Club Pro Shop for clarification.

# Bartram Trail Ladies Golf Association News

The Bartram Trail Ladies Golf Association have been invited to submit an application for membership in the CSRA Ladies Golf Association which has approximately 350 members. As some of you know, there are 15 golf clubs in the Aiken/Augusta area that belong to the CSRA Ladies Golf Association, and they include:

The CSRA holds a Round Robin once a month at one of these clubs, they also have an annual 54 hole tournament held at three different clubs, as well as a Lady Pro Tournament once a year. The Lady Pro comprises of three players who play along with their Pro. The Round Robins are composed of ladies with low and high handicaps; you are paired in a foursome with ladies who have the same handicaps you do.

In addition, each club can have a Golf Team. The Golf Team has an outing once a month at a different club. It is comprised of 6 players and you play Match Play. It does not have to be the same 6 players each month, but includes the lowest 6 handicaps of ladies who are available to play on the day it is scheduled. You don't have to have a low handicap to be on the Golf Team. Many clubs field their team with some handicaps of 25-35 due to lack of low handicap players that are available. We would not have to have a golf team, some do and some don't. I have played on a Golf Team and it is a lot of fun!

Should we join the CSRA Ladies Golf Association it does not mean that you have to play in the Round Robins or on Team Play, it is an option. It's a good opportunity to play at a different club every month and meet other lady golfers in the area. The fees to play are very reasonable as the clubs can not charge green fees. Fees include a luncheon afterwards for Round Robins and for Team Play you only pay cart fees as there is no luncheon afterwards. There are numerous prizes awarded at each of the events.

In order to qualify for CSRA Membership we must form a Bartram Trail Ladies Association and have at least 12 members who are willing to join the CSRA Ladies Association. Cost is \$10 a year for the CSRA membership.

We presently have 17 lady members at Bartram Trail which certainly qualifies us for CSRA membership. I already have 8 ladies who are willing to join. We have one more who will join our club IF we join the CSRA. You must be a member of Bartram Trail to be eligible for membership in the CSRA Ladies Golf Association.

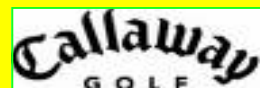
