Superintendent's Corner... From Jeff Lloyd

“...Most of the Tree Work is done, we'll be laying sod in some areas where trees were removed...”

What's Happening on the course in June and July...

As most of the membership has noticed if you have been out to the course in the past month, we have pretty much finished up all the tree work from our recent storms. We are still working towards removing blown over stumps and filling them in with dirt.

We'll also sod some areas where trees were near #1 green, #2 green, #8 fairway, #10 green, and possibly some other areas.

We are also running a test on wetting agents on the rough hoping to dry out the fairways while keeping the rough alive. What I'll be doing is running extra water on the fairway in order to get the rough even a little wet. This product will hold moisture in the rough while not leaving excess water in the fairway.

Members, you can help us by keeping your golf carts out of high traffic areas, staying off extremely dry areas, and please use the 90-degree rule. Also, we encourage you to walk whenever you can...it's good for you, and the course!

Homeowner Tips for June and July...

Adjust your irrigation system as needed. By this I mean to turn it off when it's raining and add time to the system during dry spells. It will save you money and your grass.

One last thing...pray for some rain!

Points will be scored as follows: 6 Eagle, 4 Birdie 2 Par 1 for Bogey ...
